- Yesterday** 2019 116 minutes COMEDY/MUSIC/FANTASY
- The whole world is momentarily hit with a massive blackout during which Jack is hit by a bus. Upon regaining consciousness, Jack learns to his astonishment that he is apparently now the only one who knows the music of the Beatles. He's about to become a very big deal.
- Richard Jewell** 2019 129 minutes BIOGRAPHY/CRIME/DRAMA
- Based on the true story of Richard Jewell, a security guard who discovered a bomb and saved many lives at a concert at Centennial Olympic Park during the 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta, Georgia. He was seen as a hero by many and a suspect by the FBI and the press.
- Jojo Rabbit** 2019 108 minutes COMEDY/DRAMA/WAR
- "Jojo" Betzler, is a Hitler Youth member who finds out his mother is hiding a Jewish girl in their attic. He must then question his beliefs, while dealing with the intervention of his imaginary friend, a fanciful version of Adolf Hitler with a comedic stand on the politics of the war.
- The Lady in the Van** 2015 104 minutes BIOGRAPHY/COMEDY/DRAMA
- The true story of Alan Bennett's strained friendship with Miss Mary Shepherd, an eccentric homeless woman who Bennett befriended in the 1970s before allowing her to "temporarily" park her Bedford van in the driveway of his Camden house.
- Juliet, Naked** 2018 112 minutes COMEDY/DRAMA/MUSIC
- A comic account of having a second chance in life. It's the story of Annie, (the long-suffering girlfriend of Duncan) and her unlikely transatlantic romance with the once revered, now faded, singer-songwriter, Tucker Crowe, who also happens to be the subject of Duncan's musical obsession.
- Official Secrets** 2019 112 minutes BIOGRAPHY/DRAMA/CRIME
- British Intelligence whistle-blower Katharine Gun who, during the immediate run-up to the 2003 Iraq invasion, leaked to the press a top secret NSA memo exposing a joint US-UK illegal spying operation against members of the UN Security Council.
- Judy** 2019 118 minutes DRAMA/BIOGRAPHY/ROMANCE
- Thirty years after starring in *The Wizard of Oz* (1939), legendary performer Judy Garland arrives in London in the winter of 1968 to perform a series of sold-out concerts. While there, she reminisces with friends and fans and begins a whirlwind romance with musician Mickey Deans, her soon-to-be fifth husband.
- Little Women** 2019 135 minutes DRAMA, ROMANCE
- In the years after the civil war, Jo March reflects back and forth on her life, telling the beloved story of the March sisters –four young women, each determined to live life on her own terms, as they learn to navigate love, loss, and the trials of growing up.
- Sorry We Missed You** 2019 101 minutes DRAMA
- Hoping that self-employment through the gig economy can solve their financial woes, a hard-up UK delivery driver and his wife struggling to raise a family, end up trapped in the vicious circle of this modern-day form of labour exploitation.
- The Peanut Butter Falcon** 2019 97 minutes DRAMA/COMEDY
- A young man with Down Syndrome, runs away from the nursing home where he lives to chase his dream of becoming a professional wrestler. Together with a small-time outlaw on the run, they wind through deltas, and elude capture, in a modern Mark Twain adventure story.
